

Supper will follow. Invite your wives, husbands, kids, families, and friends for an afternoon of fun.


18 holes of golf (including cart and supper) will cost \$75; supper only will be \$25.





Boating Courtesy

To all users of Sugar Lake and especially over the 4th of July celebrations, the board would like to pass along some key statutes for operating watercraft in Minnesota. See https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/86B for complete list. We want all our friends and neighbors to have a safe and fun holiday and rest of the summer. Watch out for those new Surf Skimmers that are on the lake... boy they look like fun but harder to see a single person skimming across the water.

Subd. 5. Riding on gunwales or decking.

A person may not ride or sit and a person may not operate a motorboat while a person is riding or sitting on (i) the star-board or port gunwales; (ii) the decking over the bow, sides, or stern; or (iii) the transom, of a motorboat while underway unless the motorboat is provided with adequate guards or railing to prevent passengers from falling overboard.

Also specifically for Jetskis but many of these could apply to all watercraft out of courtesy if nothing else:

General requirements.

In addition to requirements of other laws relating to watercraft, a person may not operate or permit the operation of a personal watercraft:

- 1. between one hour before sunset and 9:30 a.m.;
- 2. at greater than slow-no wake speed within 150 feet of:
 - a. a shoreline
 - b. a dock
 - c. a swimmer
 - d. a raft used for swimming or diving
 - e. a moored, anchored, or nonmotorized watercraft;
